Create and maintain a safe, supportive and respectful place of teaching and learning.	Implement trauma informed practices across the school. Major incident reduction from 4.73 to 3.5 incidents per day. Student Disciplinary Absences reduction by 25%.

Our initiatives include

- Funding for an additional Speech Language Pathologist to support identification, intervention, and case management of learners and support improvement of A-C English achievement.
- Funding for a Deputy Principal position to support staff to:
 - Implement high yield Positive Behaviour for Learning practices.
 - Develop and implement Trauma Informed Practices across the whole school with consistency and fidelity as part of the Positive Behaviour for Learning framework.
 - Improve case management practises to ensure that all students receive appropriate targeted support to improve their A-C English achievement.
- Support students who require intensive social-emotional teaching by providing expert trauma informed practices through the Reboot Space, explicit instruction of skills and case management. This targeted support will ensure increased learning engagement, a reduction in major incidents, and an improvement in A-C English achievement.
